



WHERE DO WE BELONG?

BIBLE STORY: One God but Many Gifts (1 Corinthians 12)

BIBLE TRUTH: We are commanded to love and honor the gifts God has given believers.

BIBLE VERSE: And there are different activities, but the same God works all of them in each person. *1 Corinthians 12:6*

BONUS VERSE: Everyone must appear with a gift suited to his means, according to the blessing the LORD your God has given you. *Deuteronomy 16:17*

During our meeting this week, we learned how Paul wrote a letter to the Corinthian church. He told them that before learning about God, they didn't know who or what to believe. If they trusted Jesus as Savior, Paul assured the Corinthians that God gave them gifts. Paul told them that these gifts are to help God's church. There is one Spirit, but there are many gifts that God gives to Christians. God wants Christians to honor and love the gifts He has given them.

Talk about why people enjoy receiving gifts and what we feel when we receive gifts from others. Brainstorm with your child what his or her favorite gift was that he or she has ever received. Tell your child that God gives us spiritual gifts when we trust Jesus as our Savior.

Invite your child to consider if he or she has trusted in Jesus as Savior. If not, share the gospel of Jesus Christ with your child. Tell your child that salvation is the greatest gift God has given us!

Draw a picture about how you feel about the gifts God gives us when we trust Jesus as our Savior. Suggest drawing a happy face or anything else that shows our happiness for the gifts God gives. Pray and thank God for giving us the best gift in Jesus and for allowing us to share in the gifts He gives believers.
