



HOW CAN I BE KIND TO OTHERS?

BIBLE STORY: The Kindness of God (Titus 3)

BIBLE TRUTH: Jesus helps us be kind to others.

BIBLE VERSE: Be kind ... to all people. *Titus 3:2*

Your preschooler is learning about the kindness of God. Your child learned, "Be kind ... to all people" (Titus 3:2). This week help reinforce this truth with your child by reminding him that Jesus helps us be kind to others. Spend time talking about ways you and your family can show grace and kindness to those around you.

God has shown us grace and kindness through Jesus. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, God helps us show kindness and grace to others because we recognize God's incredible mercy and kindness to us through the gospel. We should be quick to ask for forgiveness when we've wronged someone and quick to forgive others.

Jesus taught that we can tell others we are sorry when we hurt them. The Book of Titus is a letter written by the apostle Paul to his friend, Titus. Titus was a church leader. In his letter, Paul reminded Titus of how to be a good leader of the church. He told him to remind people to obey the laws of the government leaders. Paul said to also tell the church people to be kind and gentle. This is a way they could show God's kindness.

As believers, we should also remember that we were once unbelievers, but God showed incredible kindness and mercy to us by sending Jesus. We didn't do anything to deserve it. It was a free gift from God. We can show our gratefulness for God's love and mercy by doing good things for others to help them so that they will see Jesus in us.
