



## WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?

**BIBLE STORY:** Many Ways to Serve (1 Corinthians 12)

**BIBLE TRUTH:** God made me to do many things well that give Him praise.

**BIBLE VERSE:** There are different activities, but the same God. *1 Corinthians 12:6a*

In today's meeting, TeamKIDs will answer the question, "Where do I belong?" God made people able to do many things well. We can use what God made us able to do to praise and serve Him. We belong in God's family because He is the one who made us and chooses what each of us can do well.

In 1 Corinthians 12, we read a letter from Paul to the church in Corinth. Paul wanted the people to know that God gives different abilities to people and gives each person the ability he needs to do the work God wants him to do. Paul also wrote about how the church should work together similar to the way a person's body works. Each body part has a different ability, but all the parts are needed to work together. Similarly, the church needs all the people with their different abilities to work together.

This week, remind your child about how God is our Creator and made each person to be special and unique. Talk about how people have different abilities and each person can do certain activities well. As you pray with your child this week, thank God for making people able to think, work, and do many things well. Ask God to help your family members find new ways to use what they can do to serve Him.
